Riley's Bio:

Overview:

Riley is an athletic 72 lb. dog that is lightning fast. He is burning with desire for anything related to retrieve or hunt. He will work non-stop from morning to evening whether in training, in the field or in the marsh. Riley is an intense and driven dog who gives 100% to everything he does. Riley is a dynamo. He is NOT a plodder.

Riley has excelled as a hunt test dog achieving "Master Hunter" status in AKC and "Grand Master Hunting Retriever" status in NAHRA. His record has few blemishes. He is an excellent marker and rarely requires handling to a down bird. Riley is known for having "one foot on the gas and one foot on the brake" at all times. His water entries are typically large and stylish. He is very athletic and loves to "gets big air" like a dock dog. Riley runs his blinds with as much intensity as marks yet he is always whistle-compliant and handles exceptionally well. Riley's hunt test record includes qualification in the 2013 NAHRA Invitational.

At the end of the 2014 Hunt Test season, I decided to try working Riley for field trial competition. I have always believed that Riley was exceptional and was only being held back by my ability and resources for training. I decided to quit living on that excuse and give it a try for one season. This is a very difficult transition for a life-long hunt test dog and we did not fare very well in our first two or three introductory attempts in Qualifying Stakes. In our fourth "Q" we made it to the water blind (3rd series). In our fifth "Q", we were knocking on the door of a win having had great performances in the first three series placing us in the "catbird seat" of the final seven teams for the last series. Unfortunately this was not to be our day as Riley marked the 290 yard memory bird perfectly but hunted just short. After a long hunt that pulled Riley away from the immediate fall area, I called him in without a bird, realizing later that I should have handled him to complete the trial and a possible JAM. Our sixth "Q" attempt resulted in a completed trial and the Reserve JAM. Clearly we were making progress. Seven turned out to be our lucky number as we won the Central New York "Q" in August 2015 and achieved QAA status. Given this achievement, we'll dedicate the 2016 season to running ALL AGE stakes to see how much we can achieve.

In the pheasant field, Riley has few peers. He has hunted wild birds on the Great Plains since his first birthday. He also regularly hunts released pheasants in Pennsylvania, New York and Ohio as well as wild ruffed grouse. Riley proactively and relentlessly searches for game scent when there is none, not just hunting scent when it is available. Riley is the real deal and has a great nose to support his effort. He courses the field with style, grace, speed and thoroughness in a non-stop effort to locate game scent. Once scent is made, there will no doubt be a flush forthcoming. Following the shot Riley's retrieving instincts and training take over so no birds are lost. In addition to his excellent marking ability, he is skilled and seasoned at trailing and running down cripples.

Riley also excels as waterfowl dog having retrieved geese and ducks in New York, Pennsylvania and Ohio. He works from sneak boats, land blinds, layout blinds and marsh stands. When there are

wings in the air he will scan the skies intently. During long hours of inactivity, he will find a corner of the boat to lie down. When the birds hit the water, Riley is ready for action; efficiently retrieving downed game so the next flight of birds can set their wings to clean dekes.

At home Riley is a calm fellow and a good citizen. He is a well behaved house dog, and does not live in a kennel. Riley has a very endearing personality and loves attention. He is an affectionate dog who loves being with people. Riley truly believes everyone should be his best friend and will go out of his way to show it. During my business travel Riley often stays with my daughter, son-in-law and infant – toddler grandchildren. Riley is known for being docile and tolerant of all tugging, poking, hugging and being crawled upon to which he is subjected.

Blood Lines:

Sire and Dam: Riley was bred and born to hunt. His Sire (**MPR Brock's Golden Nugget**) and Dam (**CPR HPK's Blowin' in the Wind**) were selected specifically for their hunting prowess. Nugget was an APLA titled Master Pointing Retriever and Windy was titled as a Certified Pointing Retriever. Both were outstanding upland dogs spending their lives hunting the Midwest and Great Plains. Windy was used as a preserve guide dog at R&R Pheasant Preserve in South Dakota.

2nd generation (four dogs): Riley's grandparents are as follows:

MHR Wyvernaxe Audley MH x Lady Chasity of Windy Hill SH

and

4XGMPR HRCH Black Forest's Bear Grits MH x CPR HPK's Layla

All of these dogs are proven hunting and hunt test performers. "Brock" (Wyvernaxe Audley) was imported from England, his father (Ft Ch Bellever Actor) having been a winner of multiple field trials. "Brock" himself is somewhat famous as a stud dog particularly in Pointing Lab circles. He was a stylish upland hunter and also achieved AKC Master Hunter and NAHRA Grand Master status. "Bear" (Black Forest's Bear Grits) has achieved numerous Master / Grand Master certifications in AKC, HRC and APLA, and has won and placed in numerous national and regional gun dog challenge events. Bear is likely a future candidate for the APLA Hall of Fame following in the footsteps of his father "Grits". Below listed are Bear's gundog challenge achievements:

Third generation (eight dogs): The eight dogs representing Riley's great-grandparents consist of a an English Field Trial Champion, Canadian National Champion, two FC/AFC dogs, two hunt test dogs titled by APLA and AKC, one of which (Grits) is a member of the APLA Hall of Fame.

Fourth – Seventh generation: Digging deeper into Riley's pedigree, it is laden with high performance dogs. There are 254 dogs in a seven generation pedigree. In Riley's blood line there

are 20 individual Field Trial Hall Of Fame dogs, with a total of 42 occurrences. There are 170 Field Trial Champion titles along with numerous hunt test titles. There is a "Kellogg's" line which is known to be prototypical American working stock. The foundation is deep and dense with high performance retrievers in every generation.
